

Loch Ness, Glencoe and The Highlands

☆ Tour Highlights | Loch Ness Cruise & Urquhart Castle, Glencoe, The Great Glen & Loch Lomond




We begin our day travelling into the Highlands. First stopping on the shores of Loch Lomond and then journeying further north into majestic Glencoe. Here we experience the haunting glen where the 1692 massacre of the MacDonald clan took place, and where 007 himself walked the stunning landscape in the film, Skyfall.

After a lunch stop in the Fort William area, we continue north, passing breathtaking views of Ben Nevis and

the Caledonian Canal. Loch Ness is our next stop of the day; the well-known body of water is home to 'Nessie,' the Loch Ness monster. You have the choice to take a relaxing boat cruise[£] and visit Urquhart Castle[£] located on the banks of the loch.

We then begin our return journey to the lowlands, passing through Inverness, Capital of the Highlands, and through the Grampian Mountains. We pause for a short refreshment break at the Highland town of Pitlochry, before we return to Glasgow.






Loch Lomond, The Trossachs National Park and Stirling Castle



Departing Glasgow, we travel north to The Trossachs National Park and stop at Loch Lomond, Scotland's largest loch. The area was once home to Scotland's highland folk hero, Rob Roy MacGregor. Here you can choose to take a scenic hour-long cruise, £ taking in views of the islands and surrounding mountains.


From Loch Lomond, we continue in the footsteps of Rob Roy MacGregor and enjoy a refreshment break in Aberfoyle; a small town nestled in the heart of Scotland's first National Park.



We then journey to Stirling, where we have the opportunity to visit its magnificent castle[£]. Situated high on volcanic rock, the castle offers tales of key historic figures such as William Wallace, Robert the Bruce and Mary Queen of Scots, as well as the stunning views of the surrounding landscape.

With lots of interesting things to see and do, the Stirling Castle experience is well worth a visit before we return to Glasgow.

TOUR 3 | 1 DAY TOUR



Oban, Glencoe and West Highland Castles

☆ Tour Highlights | Oban, Inveraray & Castle, Glencoe & Loch Lomond

Leaving Glasgow, we journey north west, passing through the Highlands and towards the west coast. We reach Inveraray; perched on the banks of Loch Fyne, the town was first established in 1745 by the chief of the Clan Campbell. We stop with time to explore its Castle[£] and Gardens, or wander the Georgian streets of the town itself.

Leaving Inveraray, we travel north, witnessing many dramatic scenes such as Kilchurn Castle on Loch Awe. We stop for lunch in Oban for time to explore and


visit McCaig's Folly – Scotland's version of the Colosseum.

Next to tick off your bucket list before reaching the famous Glencoe valley is Castle Stalker on Loch Laich. Here you will experience the glen where the 1692 massacre of the MacDonald clan took place. It also features in the Harry Potter films and in the opening credits for the Outlander TV series.

The final stop will be on the banks of Loch Lomond in the small village of Luss, before heading back to Glasgow.





Glenfinnan, Mallaig and Glencoe Adventure

PLEASE NOTE: We do not board the Jacobite Steam Train on this tour.

We begin our tour journeying north, hugging the shoreline of Loch Lomond and travelling through the Trossachs National Park. We stop at Glencoe, famous for the massacre of the MacDonald clan, and also the filming location of James Bond's Skyfall and Harry Potter and the Prisoner of Azkaban.

We then travel further north, pausing in the Fort William area for refreshments before we reach the Road to the Isles, or 'Rathad nan Eilean'. The area is said to have some of the most spectacular scenery in the world, with sandy beaches and dramatic hills. At the end of the road, we reach Mallaig, a scenic fishing port. Spend time here for lunch and enjoy the sea views.

We then travel eastwards to the highlight of our day, Glenfinnan Viaduct. Here we arrive in time to see the Harry Potter train cross the bridge; don't forget your camera for that iconic photo! The area has wonderful views across Loch Shiel; filming location of Harry Potter's 'Black Lake', Buckbeak's beautiful flight and scenes from the Triwizard Tournament. The loch was even used as the setting for Hogwarts.

After Glenfinnan, our tour turns south, stopping for a comfort break on the shores of Loch Lomond before returning to Glasgow.

Enjoy two days in the Highlands; experience dramatic landscapes rich in history and enjoy an overnight stay in the Highland town of Fort William.

DAY ONE: Explore the Wallace Monument[†], the towering stone testimonial to William Wallace, which contains his broadsword; pass by Doune Castle, location for the TV series, Outlander, and Monty Python & the Holy Grail; journey to Glencoe, site of the massacre of the MacDonald Clan and end your day at Glenfinnan Viaduct; made famous by the Harry Potter Films (Apr-Oct).

DAY TWO: After breakfast, explore the Great Glen and Loch Ness, enjoy a photo stop at Glen Garry and visit Eilean Donan Castle[‡]; one of Scotland's most photographed castles. Afterwards, stop for lunch at Loch Ness, enjoy a break at the foot of Ben Nevis, Britain's highest mountain. Journey homewards, enjoying photo stops through the Highlands before crossing the Forth Road Bridge back to Edinburgh. If returning to Glasgow, your Guide will offer you complimentary train tickets for your return to Glasgow Queen Street Rail Station.



Isle of Skye, The Highlands and Loch Ness

Tour Highlights | Portree, Dunvegan Castle, Kilt Rock, Eilean Donan Castle & Loch Ness

DAY ONE: We begin our adventure at the picturesque conservation village of Luss, on the 'bonnie, bonnie banks' of Loch Lomond. Travelling north we enjoy time to admire Glencoe, site of the 1692 massacre of the MacDonald Clan. After lunch, we pause at Britain's highest mountain, Ben Nevis, then pass the stunning Five Sisters of Kintail mountain range. Our day ends in the charming village of Portree.

DAY TWO: We begin a full day's exploration of Skye. The itinerary here is flexible; you may enjoy a visit to Dunvegan Castle[£] and Kilt Rock, a walk at Lealt Falls, or to learn

the history of iconic Scot Flora MacDonald. Discuss these options and more with your Driver-Guide on the day.

DAY THREE: We return via Eilean Donan Castle[£], the backdrop to several films including 'Highlander'. We then stop at Loch Ness for lunch and perhaps a chance to see its famous monster. Our journey south continues over Laggan and the Grampian Mountains with our last stop in Pitlochry, before returning to Edinburgh. If continuing to Glasgow, you will receive a free ticket to Glasgow Queen Street Rail Station.




