

The Isle of Skye and Eilean Donan Castle

We travel south, pausing for a comfort break on the shore of Loch Ness; allowing time for some Nessie hunting! We continue onwards to Eilean Donan Castle[£], situated on the beautiful Loch Duich. Enjoy time to visit one of Scotland's most photographed castles, before we journey over to the Isle of Skye.

We stop for lunch at the picturesque island town of Portree. Despite its size, it is the capital of Skye and is surrounded by rocky cliffs and rolling hills. Moving

on, we visit various points of interest on Skye such as the Old Man of Storr, an iconic rock formation formed by an ancient landslide, and Kilt Rock, for amazing coastal views. After spending the afternoon exploring Skye and admiring its stunning scenery, we begin our return journey home, stopping at various beauty points on the way back to Inverness.





Departing Inverness, we follow the Caledonian Canal to its source at Loch Ness. At 24 miles long and over 700 feet deep, the loch is the largest by volume in the British Isles and is famous for sightings of 'Nessie', the Loch Ness Monster. Maybe you'll spot her on your tour!

We travel onwards, stopping at Urquhart Castle[£], overlooking the loch. There is time here to explore its grounds and enjoy beautiful views over Loch Ness. We continue to Invermoriston for a

photo stop at its spectacular waterfall before reaching Fort Augustus, where we will enjoy a lunch break and have the opportunity to take a cruise[£] across Loch Ness.

After lunch, we pause at the Falls of Foyers, a magnificent 16ft waterfall, and Dores Beach, nestled on the shores of Loch Ness. The beach is arguably one of the best viewpoints of the loch. Enjoy your stunning surroundings before returning home to Inverness.







Leaving Inverness, we are able to enjoy some of the city's sights as we make our way to our first stop, Culloden Battlefield, the location where the 1745 Jacobite Rising came to an end. After this, we head to the Clava Cairns, giving a glimpse into what life was like over 4,000 years ago and into society of Scotland in the Bronze Age.

We then travel to Fort George, an imposing fort built in the wake of the Battle of Culloden that took over



22 years to build and is still in use as an active army base today.

After soaking up the history here, we head to the beautiful seaside town of Nairn for lunch before venturing into the Cairngorms National Park. Here you can enjoy the stunning surroundings and perhaps spot some local wildlife at Loch an Eilein. After a short stop in Aviemore, we head back to Inverness where our tour ends.

Glenfinnan, Mallaig and Loch Ness Adventure

Tour Highlights | Urquhart Castle, Glenfinnan Viaduct, Mallaig, Fort Augustus, Loch Ness



We begin our tour journeying south, hugging the shoreline of Loch Ness for our first stop of the day; Urquhart Castle. Enjoy a photo stop here with beautiful views of Scotland's most famous loch, and perhaps even spot Nessie!

We then travel to the Glenfinnan Viaduct for the highlight of our day; the Jacobite Steam Train*. Arrive in time to enjoy the view of the train crossing the bridge and snap that iconic photo. You will also get beautiful views across Loch Shiel which was used as the setting for Hogwarts in the *Harry Potter* films.



We journey westwards on the 'Road to the Isles' or 'Rathan nan Eilean'. The area is said to have some of the most spectacular scenery in the world, with sandy beaches, dramatic hills, and unforgettable sea views. At the end of the road, we reach Mallaig, a scenic fishing port. Spend time here for lunch and enjoy the sea views.

Departing Mallaig, we begin our journey home. We enjoy a photo opportunity at the Falls of Foyers and Dores Beach, with beautiful views over Loch Ness before we return to Inverness

Applecross, Loch Carron and the Wild Highlands

Tour Highlights | Applecross, Loch Carron, Bealach na Bà, North Coast 500





Departing from Inverness using the lower part of the North Coast 500 route, we cross the beautifully scenic Black Isle before stopping in the villages of Lochcarron and Achintraid. Enjoy breathtaking views over Loch Kishorn and a magnificent mountain range on the opposite shore.


We then climb upwards through dramatic landscape over the Bealach na Bà ('Pass of the Cattle'). The road is the third highest in Britain at over 2,000 feet; we'll pause for photos at the summit with



magnificent views across Raasay and the Isle of Skye.

We start our descent into Applecross for free time to explore the village and have lunch. Afterwards, we begin our return journey with a relaxing drive along the banks of Loch Torridon and through the Beinn Eighe National Nature Reserve. We pass through the villages of Shieldaig and Kinlochewe, stopping for photos and refreshments, before we return to Inverness

John O'Groats, Dunrobin Castle and the Far North

Tour Highlights | Dunrobin Castle, Loch Fleet, John O'Groats

We begin our tour heading north, stopping at Loch Fleet for your chance to spot some of the local wildlife like puffins and seals. Next is Scotland's very own fairy-tale castle; Dunrobin Castle[£], the family seat of Clan Sutherland. It resembles a French château with its towering spires and overlooks the Moray Firth. You'll have time to explore the beautiful stately home, its gardens, tearoom, and museum.

We then travel further north, stopping for a lunch break before we reach the highlight of our day; John O'Groats, the most northerly point on the British Mainland. Here, you'll be able to stroll along the cliff path with dramatic coastal views, take your own iconic photo at the signpost, and perhaps see some local wildlife.

We begin our journey homeward bound, travelling to Dunbeath Harbour for photos and Brora, famous for its magnificent coastal scenery, before arriving in Inverness.

Sometimes just one day on the Isle of Skye isn't enough to truly take in all of its beauty, history and folklore. This 2-day tour with an overnight stay in Portree takes you to some of the most spectacular sites on the island whilst passing through some of the most beautiful highland scenery.

DAY ONE: Departing from Inverness, we begin our journey towards the Isle of Skye, stopping at Achnasheen for a comfort break. From there, we arrive at Loch Carron for a quick photo stop before reaching Kyle of Lochalsh.

After a drive through some spectacular island scenery, we arrive at Dunvegan Castle[£]. Continuously run by the same family for over 800 years, Dunvegan Castle stands on the shore of Loch Dunvegan with the current structure dating back to around 1266. Take time here to explore the castle and its history or, if you prefer, head into Dunvegan village for lunch and to explore.

Then we venture to the imposing and dramatic Quiraing, part of the Trotternish mountain range. Be sure to have your camera ready to take some photos of this magnificent landscape, characterised by its high cliffs and pinnacles of rock caused by a gigantic landslip. We then head off to take in 3 more of Skye's most iconic landmarks; Kilt Rock for amazing coastal views, Lealt Falls, and the Old Man of Storr, an iconic rock formatic formed by an ancient landslide.

We end our day by heading to Portree where we check into our accommodation for the night. Despite its size, the charming town of Portree is actually the capital of Skye.

DAY TWO: After breakfast, we will depart Portree and head towards one of the most magical places in Scotland; the Fairy Pools. Shrouded in mystery and home to many myths and legends, you might want to bring a pair of walking boots to help you reach them.

Following a couple of comfort and photo stops at Sligachan and Sconser, we travel to Broadford where you can enjoy some lunch and keep an eye out for some local wildlife, with otters, seals, and even killer whales spotted in the past.

Then, it's onto our 2nd castle of the tour – Eilean Donan[£]; one of Scotland's most photographed castles and situated on its own island at the head of Loch Duich. Explore the atmospheric surroundings here and take some great photographs.

We then return back to Inverness via the scenic village of Fort Augustus at the foot of Loch Ness. Enjoy stunning views of the massive loch and keep an eye out for 'Nessie' as you pass.


