Our journey begins bright and early, departing Edinburgh and travelling north to the heart of the Highlands. We stop for breakfast at Kilmahog or the Smiddy, with the possibility of seeing a Highland coo depending on the time of year. Onwards, we pass through Rob Roy Country and stop at Glencoe, one of Scotland's most famous glens, for a photo opportunity.

Continuing via Loch Linnhe, we take a break in the Fort William area for lunch and then pass beneath Britain's highest mountain, Ben Nevis. We continue through the pretty village of Fort Augustus, hugging the loch's shoreline as we head towards Urquhart Castle. Loch Ness is most famous for sightings of the Loch Ness Monster, affectionately known as "Nessie". Enjoy time at Loch Ness, where you can choose to explore the ruins of **Urquhart Castle**<sup>£</sup> and take a relaxing boat **cruise**<sup>£</sup> across the loch.

We then begin our journey home, travelling through Inverness, capital of the Highlands, and stopping for evening refreshments in the town of Pitlochry, before returning to Edinburgh.


THE KELPIES

We depart Edinburgh and enjoy our first photo stop of the day at The Kelpies; the tallest sculpture in Scotland and the biggest equine sculpture in the world. Afterwards, we continue westwards to Loch Lomond, the largest loch in Scotland. Here, you will have the time to enjoy an hour-long cruise<sup>£</sup> taking in spectacular views of the loch's many islands and surrounding mountains. Our journey continues through the Trossachs National Park, also known as the Highlands in miniature for its abundance of lochs.



mountains, and forests. We will have lunch in the area, famous as the homeland of the legendary outlaw Rob Roy MacGregor.

We continue onwards through the pretty town of Callander, passing Doune Castle, to our final stop of the day; the magnificent **Stirling Castle**. The site is one of Scotland's most historically significant fortresses, sitting high on volcanic rock. Take time to visit the castle and learn about the exploits of key historic figures such as William Wallace and Robert the Bruce, before returning to Edinburgh.



We begin our tour journeying into the Highlands and pausing for refreshments before we stop at Glencoe. The glen is famous for the 1692 massacre of the MacDonald clan, and as a filming location in James Bond's *Skyfall*.

We then continue further north, pausing in the Fort William area for our lunch break before we travel westwards to the highlight of our day, the Glenfinnan Viaduct. We arrive in time to see the *Harry Potter* train cross the bridge\*; don't forget your camera for that iconic photo! The area has wonderful views

across Loch Shiel, which you might recognise as the setting for Hogwarts. The Glenfinnan area was also where Bonnie Prince Charlie launched the 1745 Jacobite Rebellion.

After Glenfinnan, we will visit Neptune's Staircase – a series of water locks on the Caledonian Canal that raises the canal by 19m over a quarter of a mile. As we leave that feat of engineering behind, we head to the Victorian town of Pitlochry before we arrive back to Edinburgh.




We begin our tour travelling northwest, starting the day with a visit to **Doune**Castle<sup>£</sup>, which featured in the cult movie Monty Python and the Holy Grail, the Outlander series, and the set for Game of Thrones' Winterfell.

From Doune, we travel into the Highlands, passing Loch Lubnaig and up through Glen Ogle, stopping nearby for lunch with beautiful views of the surrounding area. Afterwards, we enjoy views of Kilchurn Castle, nestled on the banks of Loch Awe,

before reaching Inveraray, a small 18th century town on the shore of Loch Fyne. Here, we have time to explore the town or visit Inveraray Castle<sup>£</sup>, home to the Clan Campbell and featured in the TV series *Downton Abbey*.

We then begin our homeward journey, driving over the Arrochar Alps with a brief pause at the Rest and Be Thankful pass. A little later we reach Loch Lomond, stopping at the lochside village of Luss before returning to Edinburgh.









GLENTURRET DISTILLERY

Our whisky tour begins by venturing north into the Highlands. We head towards Dewar's Aberfeldy Distillery for the first whisky themed stop of the day.

Spend 2 hours here for their whisky and chocolate tasting tour<sup>£</sup>, comprising of a guided tour of the distillery, warehouse, and heritage exhibition. Plus, a tasting of Aberfeldy's 12-year-old single malt whisky, the premium Dewar's 12-year-old blended Scotch, and the super-premium 18-year-old blended Scotch, matched

with chocolate sourced from a local chocolatier.

Before reaching Glenturret Distillery, Scotland's oldest working distillery, we will stop for lunch in the picturesque town of Aberfeldy or in the Glenturret area. Overlooking the River Turret, Glenturret has been distilling whisky using traditional methods since 1763. Enjoy a whisky tasting<sup>£</sup> and refreshments at their distillery café before heading back to Edinburgh.

DOUNE CASTLE

We begin our *Outlander* tour by journeying towards the Tuilyies Standing Stones, much like the ones seen in the show. From there, we head to the Royal Burgh of Culross. The gardens of this seaside town feature as Claire's herb garden.


Our next stop is Doune Castle, which featured as Castle Leoch in the show and has featured in many other films and TV shows like *Game of Thrones*. Our tour then travels to **Linlithgow Palace**<sup>£</sup>, *Outlander's Wentword Prison*, with its impressive grounds overlooking



stunning scenery. We then continue to dramatic **Blackness Castle<sup>£</sup>**, known as the ship that never sailed, which features as Fort William, the headquarters of Black Jack Randall.

Our final stop of the day depends on the time of year. During summer months we will visit **Midhope Castle**<sup>£</sup>, which features as Jamie's home *Lallybroch*. During winter, or if we are unable to visit Midhope, our tour will visit the magnificent Forth Bridges viewpoint, before returning to Edinburgh.

# TOUR 7 | 1 DAY TOUR



Take the scenic coastal route south into the medieval Kingdom of Northumbria. Our first stop of the day is Holy Island; enjoy views of Lindisfarne Castle, visit the **Priory**<sup>£</sup>, and perhaps even sample some of the world-famous Lindisfarne Mead, brewed by the island's resident monks.

Continue to the bustling market town of Alnwick, where you'll find the medieval **Alnwick Castle**<sup>£</sup>. You may choose to visit the castle, home to the Percy family for over 700 years, visit the spectacular **Alnwick Garden**<sup>£</sup> with its wonderful

Grand Cascade and Poison Gardens, or spend time exploring the town centre at your leisure. You might also recognise Alnwick Castle as a filming location for both *Harry Potter* and *Downton Abbey*.

In the mid-afternoon, we begin the journey back to Edinburgh. On the way, there is the possibility for a photo stop at the Flodden Battlefield, where the Scots fought the English. After this, and a comfort break in the historic town of Coldstream, our tour will arrive back in Edinburgh.



Departing from Edinburgh, our tour will head out towards the east coast. We will arrive at our first stop of the day, Holy Island, home to Lindisfarne Castle, the Priory, and even the resident monks who produce Lindisfarne Mead. Should this not be possible, we will instead visit the seaside village of St Abbs, which you may recognise as New Asgaard in Avengers: Endgame.

Continuing south, we will reach the historic town of Alnwick. Spend time here exploring the town's beautiful cobbled streets, or visit the famous winter




gardens<sup>£</sup>. Whilst it will be shut, you will also be able to see Alnwick Castle as you stroll through the town. After this, we will begin to head back north to our next stop, the magnificent Bamburgh Castle<sup>£</sup>.

Spanning nine acres of land and dating back to the 5th century, it is one of the biggest inhabited castles in the UK with a fascinating history. Spend time here to learn all about the many myths and legends associated with the castle. We then continue our journey back to Edinburgh, with a comfort break in the historic town of Coldstream.







From the heart of Edinburgh, we head towards the ancient village of Roslin to visit the amazing architecture of Rosslyn Chapel<sup>E</sup>. The novel *The Da Vinci Code* has popularised the theory of the chapel being linked to the Holy Grail.

Leaving Rosslyn Chapel, we journey through the hills and valleys of the Scottish Borders and spend some time in the historic town of Melrose. Grab some lunch, explore the picturesque town, and visit Melrose Abbey<sup>£</sup> - said



to be the burial place of the casket containing King Robert the Bruce's heart.

On our way back to Edinburgh we travel through the borders and enjoy some lovely scenic views. Our final stop is at one of the few remaining distilleries in the Lowlands – Glenkinchie. Learn about the history and processes involved in whisky making on a relaxed **tour**<sup>£</sup> before sampling some of the distillery's finest malts.





Leaving Edinburgh, we cross the Firth of Forth and enter the Kingdom of Fife. We travel through the historic fishing villages of Pittenweem and Anstruther, with photo stops to enjoy the harbour views and a refreshment break along the way.

We reach the medieval town of St Andrews in time for lunch. Enjoy a stroll through the town, famous as the home of golf, visit its impressive cathedral<sup>£</sup> and castle<sup>£</sup>, both rich in history, and see Scotland's oldest University; where



Prince William met his future wife, Kate Middleton. Enjoy approximately three hours of free time to explore the town's medieval buildings and cobbled streets. Heading homewards, we travel to Falkland for a photo stop. The village was used as the setting for Inverness in the *Outlander* series. We then head past Loch Leven and on to South Queensferry, where we make a brief stop to admire magnificent views of the Forth bridges, before we return to Edinburgh.

DAY ONE: Departing from Edinburgh, we head west to pick up passengers in Glasgow before continuing north to Loch Lomond and the Trossachs National Park for a scenic stop. If there are no Glasgow pickups, the tour will travel via Stirling. Our journey continues through the dramatic landscapes of Glencoe, where you can soak up the dramatic atmosphere and learn about the 1692 MacDonald clan massacre. We then arrive in Fort William for a loch-side lunch before visiting the Commando Memorial

with incredible views of Ben Nevis, Britain's tallest mountain. The day ends at Loch Ness, with stops at Fort Augustus and, if time permits, the historic ruins of Urquhart Castle. We then check into our accommodation in Inverness.

**DAY TWO:** After breakfast, we explore **Culloden Battlefield**<sup>£</sup> and the ancient Clava Cairns. Next, we travel through Cairngorms National Park, stopping for lunch, followed by Ruthven Barracks. On the return to Edinburgh, enjoy a possible whisky tasting at **Blair Athol Distillery**<sup>£</sup> or a stop in Pitlochry. The adventure concludes with a journey over the Queensferry Crossing back to Edinburgh.

This 2-day tour showcases Scotland's iconic landscapes and history on an unforgettable journey through the rugged Highlands.

**DAY ONE:** Our journey begins from Edinburgh, collecting passengers in Glasgow and then traveling to the charming village of Luss on Loch Lomond. After a short break, we continue to Inveraray, a historic town by Loch Fyne and home to **Inveraray Castle**<sup>£</sup>, famous from *Downton Abbey*. After lunch in town, we head north into the Highlands through the hauntingly beautiful Glencoe, site of the 1692 MacDonald massacre. Next, we stop at the Glenfinnan Viaduct. Catch a glimpse of the Jacobite Steam Train

crossing during the summer months. We finish the day in Fort William, where we'll stay overnight.

DAY TWO: After breakfast, we start with breathtaking views from Glengarry Viewpoint before heading east to Eilean Donan Castle<sup>£</sup>, Scotland's most photographed castle. Continuing to Fort Augustus at Loch Ness, we'll enjoy lunch, stunning views, and possibly a sighting of Nessie! Heading south, we stop at the Commando Memorial with views of Ben Nevis. A final stop in Dunkeld or Pitlochry offers a last taste of Highland charm before we return to Edinburgh via the Queensferry Crossing.







Our new 2-day tour from Edinburgh showcases the stunning northeast, from Dundee's V&A to the rugged Dunnottar Castle, with an overnight stay in Aberdeen, the Granite City.

**DAY ONE:** Departing Edinburgh, we head north, crossing the iconic Forth Bridges toward Dundee. Here, you can visit Scotland's V&A Museum on the banks of the River Tay. We continue to Montrose, a charming coastal town, for a lunch break. Next, marvel at the clift-top **Dunnottar Castle<sup>£</sup>** with its rugged beauty and rich history, before arriving in Stonehaven for a stroll along the seafront. Our day concludes in Aberdeen, the "Granite City," where you'll check into your



accommodation with time to explore in the evening.

DAY TWO: Following breakfast, we leave Aberdeen for Crathes Castle<sup>£</sup>, with its 16th-century turrets, gardens, and wildlife. Travelling west, we reach Ballater in Royal Deeside for a lunch break in this picturesque Victorian village within the Cairngorms National Park. The highlight of the day is Balmoral Castle<sup>£</sup>, the beloved Highland home of British royalty, where you'll tour the grounds and exhibitions. Heading south, we stop at the Devil's Elbow viewpoint for stunning Highland views before our final comfort break in Perth. We return to Edinburgh, crossing the Forth Bridges once more to end our journey.

We continue our journey where we can view Duntulm Castle, take photos at Kilt










