





Departing Inverness, we travel south, pausing for a comfort break on the shores of Loch Ness, allowing time for some Nessie hunting! Then, we continue to Eilean Donan Castle[£], situated on the beautiful Loch Duich. There's time here to explore Scotland's most photographed castle and its history, before we reach the Isle of Skye.

Once on the island, we stop for lunch at the picturesque town of Portree. Despite its size, it is the capital of Skye and is



surrounded by rocky cliffs and rolling hills. Moving on, we visit some of Skye's most spectacular sights like the Old Man of Storr, an iconic rock formation formed by an ancient landslide, and Kilt Rock for amazing coastal views.

After spending the afternoon exploring Skye's beautiful scenery, we begin our journey home, stopping at various beauty points on the way back to Inverness.




Departing Inverness, we follow the Caledonian Canal to its source at Loch Ness. At 24 miles long and over 700 feet deep, the loch is the largest by volume in the British Isles and is famous for sightings of 'Nessie', the Loch Ness Monster. Maybe you'll spot her on your tour!

We travel onwards, stopping at Urquhart Castle[£], overlooking the loch. There is time here to explore its grounds and enjoy beautiful views over Loch Ness.

We continue to Invermoriston for a photo stop at its spectacular waterfall before reaching Fort Augustus, where we will enjoy a lunch break and have the opportunity to take a cruise[£] across Loch Ness.

After lunch, we pause at the Falls of Foyers, a magnificent 16ft waterfall, and Dores Beach, nestled on the shores of Loch Ness. The beach is arguably one of the best viewpoints of the loch. Enjoy the stunning surroundings before returning home to Inverness.



Leaving Inverness, we are able to enjoy some of the city's sights as we make our way to our first stop, Culloden Battlefield, where the 1745 Jacobite Rising came to an end. After this, we head to the Clava Cairns, giving a glimpse into what life was like for the society of Scotland in the Bronze Age, over 4000 years ago.

We then travel to Fort George[£], an imposing fort built in the wake of the Battle of Culloden that took over



22 years to build and is still in use as an active army base today.

After soaking up the history here, we head to the beautiful seaside town of Nairn for lunch before venturing into the Cairngorms National Park. Here you can enjoy the stunning surroundings and perhaps spot some local wildlife. After a short stop in Aviemore, we head back to Inverness where our tour ends.



Departing Inverness, journey east through the Cairngorms' rugged landscapes to reach Cardhu Distillery[£], the first stop of your whisky journey. With roots tracing back to 1824 and a legacy tied to whisky smuggling, this distillery holds a fascinating history. At Cardhu, you'll enjoy the "Nip Round" experience, where you'll sample two distinctive whiskies and hear about the heritage of Cardhu, a key contributor to Johnnie Walker blends.

Next, we continue on to Speyside Cooperage. Here, you'll witness the intricate craftsmanship of coopering an age old tradition crucial to whisky aging. Watch skilled artisans at work in this



one-of-a-kind facility, the only working cooperage with a visitor centre in the UK.

Afterwards, we head north to Elgin, a historic Highland town where you can take a break for lunch before our final destination: Benromach Distillery[£]. This family-owned distillery prides itself on keeping Speyside's traditional whiskymaking techniques alive. Embark on a guided tour, learning about the careful processes behind each dram, and sample three exceptional whiskies that embody the heart of Speyside.

Finally, enjoy the scenic drive back to Inverness, where the Ultimate Whisky Experience concludes.

LOCH NESS & URQUHART CASTLE



We begin our tour journeying south, hugging the shoreline of Loch Ness towards our first stop of the day; Urquhart Castle. Enjoy a photo stop here with beautiful views of Scotland's most famous loch, and perhaps even spot Nessie!

We then travel to the Glenfinnan Viaduct for the highlight of our day; the Jacobite Steam Train. Arrive in time to enjoy the view of the train crossing the bridge and snap that iconic photo*. You will also get beautiful views across Loch Shiel which was used as the setting for Hogwarts in the Harry Potter films. We journey

westwards on the 'Road to the Isles' or 'Rathad nan Eilean'. The area is said to have some of the most spectacular scenery in the world, with sandy beaches, dramatic hills, and unforgettable sea views. At the end of the road we reach Mallaig, a scenic fishing port. Spend time here for lunch and enjoy the sea views.

Departing Mallaig, we begin our journey home. After a coffee break in picturesque Fort Augustus, we enjoy photo opportunities with beautiful views of Loch Ness at the Falls of Foyers and Dores Beach, before we return to Inverness.

We begin our tour heading north, stopping at Loch Fleet for your chance to spot some of the local wildlife like otters and seals. Next is Scotland's very own fairy-tale castle; Dunrobin Castle[£], the family seat of Clan Sutherland. It resembles a French château with its towering spires and overlooks the Moray Firth. You'll have time to explore the beautiful stately home, its gardens, tearoom, and museum.

After Dunrobin Castle, we continue our journey north, travelling through Helmsdale and pausing at the Emigrants Statue to learn of the history of the area.


We then travel further north, stopping for a lunch break before we reach the highlight of our day; John O'Groats, at the very top of the British mainland. Here, you'll be able to stroll along the cliff path with dramatic coastal views, take your own iconic photo at the signpost, and perhaps see some local wildlife.


We begin our journey homeward bound, travelling to Dunbeath Harbour for photos and Brora, famous for its magnificent coastal scenery, before arriving in Inverness.




Departing from Inverness using the lower part of the North Coast 500 route, we cross the beautifully scenic Black Isle before stopping in the villages of Lochcarron and Achintraid. Enjoy breathtaking views of Loch Kishorn and the magnificent mountain range on the opposite shore.

We then climb upwards through the dramatic landscape over the Bealach na Bà ('Pass of the Cattle'). The road is the third highest in Britain at over 2,000 feet; we'll pause for photos at the summit with



magnificent views across to Raasay and the Isle of Skye.

We start our descent into Applecross for free time to explore the village and have lunch. Afterwards, we begin our return journey with a relaxing drive along the banks of Loch Torridon and through the Beinn Eighe National Nature Reserve. We pass through the villages of Shieldaig and Kinlochewe, stopping for photos and refreshments, before we return to Inverness



Setting off from Inverness, we travel along the banks of Loch Ness. Here, we will have the opportunity to join a leisurely cruise[£] across the loch, keeping an eye out for Nessie of course, or, spend time on the shores of the loch.

From there, we venture deeper into the Highlands to Plodda Falls, a hidden spectacle surrounded by towering trees and lush forests. Relax in the beauty of this secluded spot, part of a broader initiative to restore natural habitats and biodiversity across the Highlands.

Next, we arrive at the Dundreggan Estate, where the charity Trees for Life works to revive the ancient Caledonian forest. After lunch here, embark on a guided tour included in your ticket price through regenerating landscapes learn all about Scotland's ever-changing wildlife and the important work of the charity.

We continue to the Falls of Foyers, cascading 200 feet into a breathtaking gorge, before concluding your journey at Dores Beach. Here, gaze upon Loch Ness from its tranquil northern shore, reflecting on a day immersed in Scotland's natural beauty and rewilding vision.



















This 2-day small group tour with an overnight stay in Portree shows off the island's most spectacular sights whilst passing through beautiful highland scenery.

DAY ONE: Departing Inverness, we journey towards the Isle of Skye, pausing for a quick break at Achnasheen before reaching Loch Carron for photos. Afterward, we continue to Kyle of Lochalsh for another brief stop.

Crossing onto Skye, we head to **Dunvegan Castle**[£] (Apr Sep)*. Situated on Loch Dunvegan's shore, this historic castle has been in the same family for over 800 years. Explore its fascinating history or enjoy lunch in Dunvegan village.

Next, we visit the breathtaking Quiraing mountain range. Its dramatic cliffs and rock formations make it a must-see for photographers. We then take in Skye's iconic landmarks: Kilt Rock,

Lealt Falls, and the Old Man of Storr, perfect additions to your Skye bucket list.

Our day concludes in Portree, where we check into your accommodation for the night.

DAY TWO: After breakfast, we visit the enchanting Fairy Pools, a magical spot steeped in legend. Walking boots are recommended for the journey to these beautiful waterfalls.












Next, we visit Eilean Donan Castle[£], one of Scotland's most photographed landmarks. Situated on its own island,


