LOCH NESS, GLENCOE & THE HIGHLANDS

🌀 Tour Highlights | Loch Ness Cruise, Glencoe, Fort Augustus, Pitlochry & Loch Lomond 🌀



We begin our day travelling into the Highlands. First stopping on the shores of Loch Lomond and then journeying further north into majestic Glencoe. Here we experience the haunting glen where the 1692 massacre of the MacDonald clan took place, and where 007 himself walked the stunning landscape in James Bond's *Skyfall*.

After a lunch stop in the Fort William area, we continue north, passing breathtaking views of Ben Nevis and

the Caledonian Canal. Loch Ness is our next stop of the day; the famous body of water is home to 'Nessie', the Loch Ness monster. You have the choice to take a relaxing boat **cruise[£]** or spend time exploring the beautiful village of Fort Augustus at the foot of the loch.

We then begin our return journey to the lowlands, with a pause for a short refreshment break in the Highland town of Pitlochry before we return to Glasgow.

Departing Glasgow, we travel north to the Trossachs National Park and stop at Loch Lomond, Scotland's largest loch. The area was once home to Scotland's highland folk here, Rob Roy MacGregor. Here, you can choose to enjoy a scenic hour-long **cruise**[£], taking in views of the islands and surrounding mountains or spend time exploring the shores of the loch instead.

After a loch-side comfort break, we continue in the footsteps of Rob Roy MacGregor and enjoy a lunch break in

Aberfoyle, a small town nestled in the heart of Scotland's first national park. We then journey to Stirling, stopping at the famous Kilmahog. If you're lucky you might spot a Highland Coo along the way.

Arriving in Stirling, you can either explore the city or visit its magnificent **castle**[£]. Situated high on volcanic rock, the castle offers tales of key historic figures such as William Wallace, Robert the Bruce, and Mary Queen of Scots, as well as stunning views of the surrounding landscape.

FORT WILLIAM

We begin our tour by heading north, passing through Loch Lomond and the Trossachs National Park, hugging the shoreline before a quick break at Tyndrum. We continue to Glencoe, renowned for its dramatic landscapes, the massacre of the MacDonald clan, and the filming location for James Bond's *Skyfall*.

We then travel further north, pausing for lunch in the Fort William area, a loch-side town sitting at the foot of Ben Nevis. After lunch, we'll travel eastwards to see the highlight of our day, the Glenfinnan Viaduct. If you're lucky you'll spot the

Jacobite steam train crossing the bridge, don't forget. your camera for that iconic photo! The area has wonderful views across Loch Shiel, which you might recognise as the setting for Hogwarts in the *Harry Potter* movies. The Glenfinnan area was also where Bonnie Prince Charlie launched the 1745 Jacobite Rebellion.

We then begin our journey back down south, stopping to admire Scottish engineering genius at Neptune's Staircase, and enjoying a coffee stop at Tarbet before we arrive back in Glasgow.

KELPIES

Our tour begins by departing Glasgow and heading to The Kelpies, the tallest equine sculpture in the world. We then travel north to the charming village of Culross, a well-preserved 17th-century village on the Fife coast. *Outlander* fans may recognize it as the setting for Cranesmuir Village.

Next, head to the medieval town of St Andrews, where you'll have time to explore its famous university, historic golf course, ancient **cathedral**[£], **castle**[£] and scenic cobbled streets. Known as the birthplace of golf, and also the meeting place of Prince William and Kate, this

town offers a wealth of history. As well as being the perfect place to taste some fresh Scottish seafood.

The tour continues to Falkland, a picturesque village with rich royal heritage. Stroll its quaint streets and visit **Falkland Palace**[£], a former favorite of the Stuart Kings and Queens, which also served as a filming location for *Outlander's* 1940s Inverness.

On the return journey, we pause at the iconic Forth Bridges - three bridges, spanning 3 centuries of Scottish engineering. Enjoy a quick photo stop here before we arrive back in Glasgow.

TOUR 5 | 1 DAY TOUR



OBAN, GLENCOE & WEST HIGHLAND CASTLES

🌀 Tour Highlights | Oban, Inveraray and Castle, Glencoe & Loch Lomond 🌀

Leaving Glasgow, we journey northwest, travelling past the bonnie banks of Loch Lomond. We continue through the lower Highlands and towards the west coast before reaching Inveraray. Perched on the banks of Loch Fyne, the town was first established in 1745 by the chief of Clan Campbell. We stop with time to explore its **castle and gardens**[£], or to wander the Georgian streets of the town.

Leaving Inveraray, we head north, passing dramatic locations like Kilchurn Castle on Loch Awe. We stop for lunch in Oban, the perfect place to try some

Scottish seafood, wander through the town, or visit McCaig's Folly.

Passing by Castle Stalker on Loch Laich, we will then reach the renowned Glencoe valley. This is the haunting glen where the 1692 massacre of the MacDonald clan took place. It also features in the *Harry Potter* films and in the opening credits for *Outlander*.

On our return journey to Glasgow, we will again pass by the shores of Loch Lomond, where there will be a short refreshment and photo stop in the picturesque loch-side village of Luss, before we reach Glasgow.

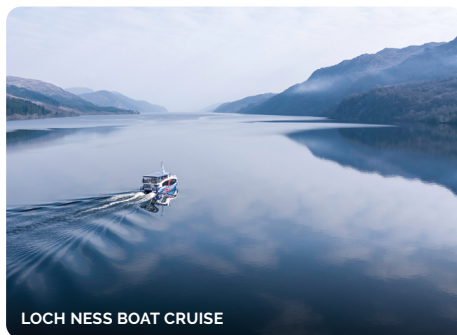
Discover Scotland's beauty on this 2-day tour! Enjoy rivers, lochs, mountains, and rich Highland history with an overnight stay in Inverness.

DAY ONE: Departing from Glasgow, we head north to Loch Lomond and the Trossachs National Park for a scenic stop. Our journey continues through the dramatic landscapes of Glencoe, where you can soak up the dramatic atmosphere and learn about the 1692 MacDonald clan massacre. We then arrive in Fort William for a loch-side lunch before visiting the Commando Memorial with incredible views of Ben Nevis, Britain's tallest mountain. The day ends at Loch Ness, with stops at Fort Augustus

and, if time permits, the historic ruins of Urquhart Castle. We then check into our accommodation in Inverness.

DAY TWO: After breakfast, we explore **Culloden Battlefield** and the ancient Clava Cairns. Next, we travel through Cairngorms National Park, stopping at Loch Morlich for lunch and some activities, followed by Ruthven Barracks. On the return to Edinburgh, enjoy a possible whisky tasting at **Blair Athol Distillery** or a stop in Pitlochry. The adventure concludes with a journey over the Firth of Forth back to Edinburgh.

If returning to Glasgow, your guide will offer you complimentary train tickets from Edinburgh.

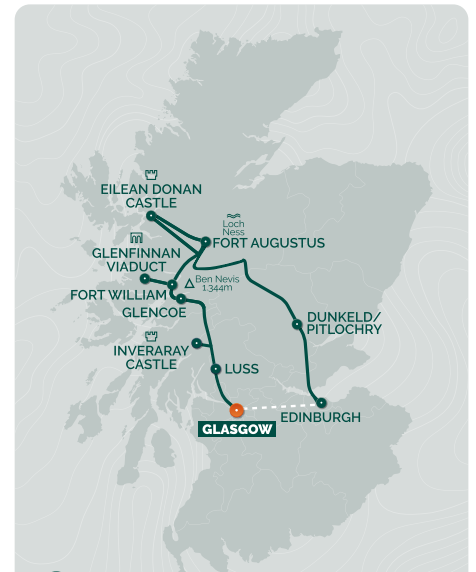

After lunch in town, we head north into the Highlands through the hauntingly beautiful Glencoe, site of the 1692 MacDonald massacre. Next, we stop at the Glenfinnan Viaduct. Possibly catch a glimpse of the Jacobite Steam Train crossing during the summer months. We finish the day in Fort William, where we'll stay overnight.

DAY TWO: After breakfast, we start with breathtaking views from Glengarry Viewpoint before heading west to **Eilean Donan Castle**£, Scotland's most photographed castle. Continuing to Fort Augustus at Loch Ness, we'll enjoy lunch, stunning views, and possibly a sighting of Nessie! Heading south, we stop at the Commando Memorial with views of Ben Nevis. A final stop in Dunkeld or Pitlochry offers a last taste of Highland charm before we return to Edinburgh crossing the Firth of Forth.

We'll then offer complimentary train tickets for all passengers heading back to Glasgow.

Discover one of Scotland's most beautiful islands on a fantastic 3-day. With castles, lochs, and mountains - this tour shows off the very best that Scotland has to offer.

DAY ONE: We begin our day by heading north before our first stop at Luss, on the banks of Loch Lomond. We pass over Rannoch Moor and stop at dramatic Glencoe, site of the 1691 massacre of the MacDonald Clan.

After lunch, we pause for photos at Britain's tallest mountain, Ben Nevis. We pass the stunning Five Sisters of Kintail mountain ridge, and end our day in Portree, where we check into our accommodation. Despite its size, the picturesque town of Portree is actually the capital of the island and is surrounded by rocky cliffs and rolling hills.

DAY TWO: After breakfast, the Isle of Skye tour will depart Portree for a full day of touring. The itinerary is flexible and can be decided on with your driver-guide. Options include **Dunvegan Castle**[£], the mystical Fairy Glens, a stop to visit Flora MacDonald's grave and the unique Black Houses, ancient dwellings of the Scottish Highlanders.

Discover the best of the west coast of Scotland on our brand-new 4-day tour. This extended adventure allows plenty of time to immerse yourself in Scotland's landscapes and culture, exploring its beauty by land, sea, and steam train. From ancient castles and charming coastal towns to dramatic Highland scenery, this is an unforgettable Scottish journey.

DAY ONE: Your Highland adventure begins as we depart Glasgow, where you'll join our Edinburgh passengers before making our first stop in the picturesque village of Luss on the banks of Loch Lomond. We'll then make our way into the West Highlands, stopping at the iconic Rest and Be Thankful stop for a few pictures before continuing our journey.

After lunch, we visit **Auchindrain Heritage Village**[£], an open-air museum that offers a fascinating insight into traditional Highland life. Continuing through Kilmartin Glen, we enjoy a short walk to discover standing stones and burial cairns dating back thousands of years.

Our day ends in the bustling seaside town of Oban, known as the "Gateway to the Isles". Here you can admire McCaig's Folly, often compared to a Scottish Colosseum, and you'll have the option to visit **Oban Distillery**[£] for a whisky tasting before settling into your accommodation for the night.

DAY TWO: We begin the day travelling through the breathtaking scenery of Glencoe, taking time for photos of its rugged peaks. Here, there is a chance that you'll see

the famous Scottish hairy coos or you'll visit Glencoe Visitor Centre to learn more about the area's history.

After an early lunch in the Fort William area, depending on availability, you'll have the option to board the **Jacobite steam train**[£], one of the world's most famous and scenic rail journeys. You'll see the iconic Glenfinnan Viaduct, made famous by the Harry Potter films, before arriving in the fishing village of Mallaig. We'll take the short ferry crossing to the Isle of Skye, enjoying stunning views along the way, before heading to Portree for the night.

DAY THREE: Our third day is dedicated to discovering the magical Isle of Skye. We begin with a visit to the enchanting Fairy Pools, followed by an optional visit



to **Talisker Distillery**[£] for a tour and tasting. We then continue to Dun Beag Broch, an ancient Iron Age structure offering panoramic views of the surrounding landscape.

After lunch and free time in **Dunvegan**[£], the afternoon is spent exploring some of Skye's most iconic sights. These include the Fairy Glen, the dramatic cliffs of the Quiraing, and the striking Kilt Rock waterfall. The day concludes with breathtaking views of the Old Man of Storr before we return to Portree for the night.

DAY FOUR: After breakfast, we bid farewell to Skye and make our first stop at the

picture-perfect **Eilean Donan Castle**[£], one of Scotland's most photographed landmarks. Travelling east, we visit Rogie Falls, a peaceful woodland setting where salmon can sometimes be seen leaping upstream.

We then arrive in Inverness, the capital of the Highlands, where there is time for lunch before continuing to **Culloden Battlefield**[£], the poignant site of the final Jacobite rising. On our journey south, we stop for refreshments in the charming Perthshire town of Pitlochry before returning to Edinburgh in the evening. Passengers will be provided with a complimentary train ticket to continue your journey back to Glasgow.

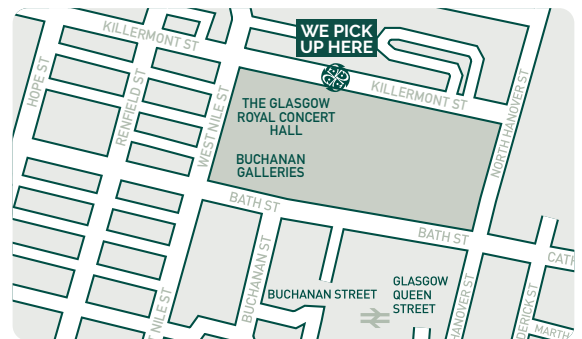
