



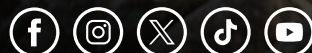

Departing Inverness, we travel south, pausing for a comfort break on the shores of Loch Ness, allowing time for some Nessie hunting! Then, we continue to **Eilean Donan Castle**<sup>£</sup>, situated on the beautiful Loch Duich. There's time here to explore Scotland's most photographed castle and its history, before we reach the Isle of Skye.

Once on the island, we'll visit Sligachan Bridge set against the beautiful Cullin Range. We'll then pause for lunch at the

picturesque town of Portree. Despite its size, it is the capital of Skye and is surrounded by rocky cliffs and rolling hills. Moving on, we visit some of Skye's most spectacular sights like the Old Man of Storr, an iconic rock formation formed by an ancient landslide, and Kilt Rock for amazing coastal views.

After spending the afternoon exploring Skye's beautiful scenery, we begin our journey home, stopping at various beauty points on the way back to Inverness.

TOUR 2 | 1 DAY TOUR



LOCH NESS & THE HIGHLANDS

🌀 Tour Highlights | Loch Ness, Urquhart Castle, Fort Augustus, Falls of Foyers and Dores Beach 🌀

Departing Inverness, we follow the Caledonian Canal to its source at Loch Ness. At 24 miles long and over 700 feet deep, the loch is the largest by volume in the British Isles and is famous for sightings of 'Nessie', the Loch Ness Monster. Maybe you'll spot her on your tour!

We travel onwards, stopping at **Urquhart Castle**<sup>£</sup>, overlooking the loch. There is time here to explore its grounds and enjoy beautiful views over Loch Ness.

We continue to Invermoriston for a photo stop at its spectacular waterfall before reaching Fort Augustus, where we will enjoy a lunch break and have the opportunity to take a **cruise**<sup>£</sup> across Loch Ness.

After lunch, we pause at the Falls of Foyers, a magnificent 16ft waterfall, and Dores Beach, nestled on the shores of Loch Ness. The beach is arguably one of the best viewpoints of the loch. Enjoy the stunning surroundings before returning home to Inverness.

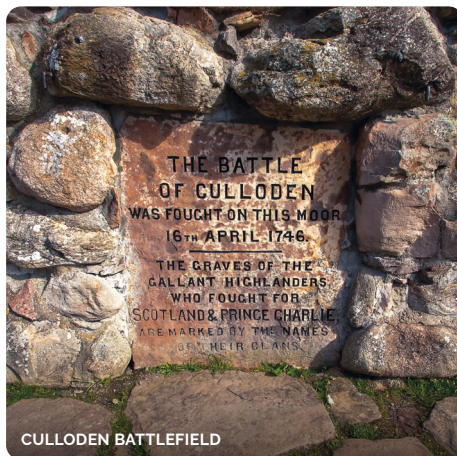

Departing in the morning, our day begins with a short tour of Inverness' sights before we continue to the **Culloden Battlefield**£, where you'll be able to step on the field where the 1745 Jacobite Rebellion came to an end. After this, we will head on to the Clava Cairns - the remains of Bronze Age burial grounds, ring cairns, and standing stones which served as the inspiration for Craigh Na Dun in the Outlander series.

We then travel to **Fort George**£, for a tour of the imposing fort built in the wake



of the Battle of Culloden. Our journey continues through the beautiful Scottish Highlands, stopping for a local lunch at the iconic Brodie Countryfare.

After lunch, we'll head to Cardhu Distillery for the **Cardhu Flavour Journey**£, where you'll learn the history of the Distillery and its founders and get to sample 3 whiskies and a highball cocktail. After experiencing Cardhu, we'll begin our journey home to Inverness, taking time to drive through the charming towns of Grantown-on-Spey and Carrbridge.

## TOUR 4 | 1 DAY TOUR

## THE ULTIMATE WHISKY EXPERIENCE - INVERNESS

🌀 Tour Highlights | Cardhu Distillery, Speyside Cooperage, Benromach Distillery, Elgin 🌀

Departing Inverness, journey east through the Cairngorms' rugged landscapes to reach **Cardhu Distillery**<sup>£</sup>, the first stop of your whisky journey. With roots tracing back to 1824 and a legacy tied to whisky smuggling, this distillery holds a fascinating history. At Cardhu, you'll enjoy the "Nip Round" experience, where you'll sample two distinctive whiskies and hear about the heritage of Cardhu, a key contributor to Johnnie Walker blends.

Next, we continue on to **Speyside Cooperage**<sup>£</sup>. Here, you'll witness the intricate craftsmanship of coopering an age old tradition crucial to whisky aging. Watch skilled artisans at work in this

one-of-a-kind facility, the only working cooperage with a visitor centre in the UK.

Afterwards, we'll head through the historic town of Elgin before stopping for Lunch in Aberlour. Then, moving on to Benromach distillery, this family-owned distillery prides itself on keeping Speyside's traditional whisky-making techniques alive. Embark on a guided tour, learning about the careful processes behind each dram, and sample three exceptional whiskies that embody the heart of Speyside.

Finally, enjoy the scenic drive back to Inverness, where the Ultimate Whisky Experience concludes.

We begin our tour journeying south, hugging the shoreline of Loch Ness towards our first stop of the day; Urquhart Castle. Enjoy a photo stop here with beautiful views of Scotland's most famous loch, and perhaps even spot Nessie!

We then travel to Glenfinnan Viaduct. Here, there is a chance that you can spot the famous Jacobite steam train, which was used as the *Hogwarts Express* in *Harry Potter*. You will also get beautiful views across Loch Shiel which was used as the setting for *Hogwarts*. We journey westwards on the 'Road to the Isles'



or 'Rathad nan Eilean'. The area is said to have some of the most spectacular scenery in the world, with sandy beaches, dramatic hills, and unforgettable sea views. At the end of the road we reach Mallaig, a scenic fishing port. Spend time here for lunch and enjoy the sea views.

Departing Mallaig, we begin our journey home. After a coffee break in picturesque Fort Augustus, we enjoy photo opportunities with beautiful views of Loch Ness at the Falls of Foyers and Dore Beach, before we return to Inverness.

## TOUR 6 | 1 DAY TOUR

## JOHN O'GROATS, DUNROBIN CASTLE &amp; THE FAR NORTH

We begin our tour heading north, stopping at Loch Fleet for your chance to spot some of the local wildlife like otters and seals. Next is Scotland's very own fairy-tale castle; **Dunrobin Castle**<sup>£</sup>, the family seat of Clan Sutherland. It resembles a French château with its towering spires and overlooks the Moray Firth. You'll have time to explore the beautiful stately home, its gardens, tearoom, and museum.

After Dunrobin Castle, we continue our journey north, travelling through Helmsdale and pausing at the Emigrants Statue to learn of the history of the area.

We then travel further north, stopping for a lunch break before we reach the highlight of our day; John O'Groats, at the very top of the British mainland. Here, you'll be able to stroll along the cliff path with dramatic coastal views, take your own iconic photo at the signpost, and perhaps see some local wildlife.

We begin our journey homeward bound, travelling to Dunbeath Harbour and passing through Brora, famous for its magnificent coastal scenery, before arriving in Inverness.

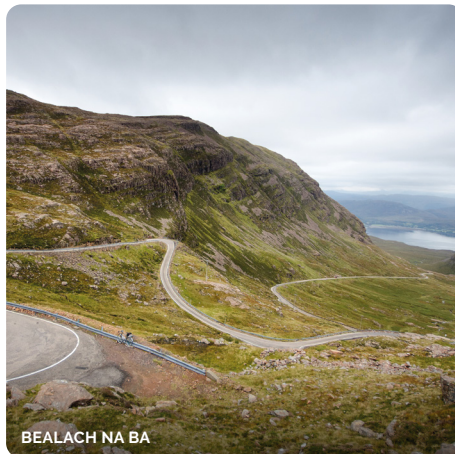
## APPLECROSS, LOCH CARRON & THE WILD HIGHLANDS

Departing from Inverness using the lower part of the North Coast 500 route, we cross the beautifully scenic Black Isle before stopping in the villages of Lochcarron and Achintraid. Enjoy breathtaking views of Loch Kishorn and the magnificent mountain range on the opposite shore.

We then climb upwards through the dramatic landscape over the Bealach na Bà ('Pass of the Cattle'). The road is the third highest in Britain at over 2,000 feet; we'll pause for photos at the summit with



magnificent views across to Raasay and the Isle of Skye.

We start our descent into Applecross for free time to explore the village and have lunch. Afterwards, we begin our return journey with a relaxing drive along the banks of Loch Torridon and through the Beinn Eighe National Nature Reserve. We pass through the villages of Shieldaig and Kinlochewe, stopping for photos and refreshments, before we return to Inverness.

TOUR 8 | 1 DAY TOUR

BLACK ISLE BREWERY, FAIRY GLEN FALLS & THE DOLPHIN COAST

🌀 Tour Highlights | Beaulieu Priory, Ben Wyvis, Dolphin Coast, Fairy Glen Falls, Black Isle Brewery 🌀

Departing from Inverness in the morning, our tour will begin by heading west towards the picturesque town of Beaulieu, stopping to visit the historic Beaulieu Priory. We'll then head to a fascinating place of myth and legend - the Cloutie Well at Munloch - where you'll have the opportunity to tie your own Cloutie.

After our dip into mythology, we continue to Cromarty. Here, you will have some free time to explore the Georgian town, grab some lunch, or even look out over the harbour and see if you can spot some dolphins before our tour continues to the famous Black Isle Brewery.

During our visit to the Black Isle Brewery, there will be time to have a tour and a tasting of their award-winning organic brews, as well as shop for some local produce. After some delicious samples, our Black Isle tour continues to the Fairy Glen, here, we will enjoy a peaceful woodland walk that culminates in a spectacular view of the twin waterfalls. Then on to Fortrose, where you will be able to visit the ruins of Fortrose Cathedral.

As we continue back to Inverness, our final port of call will be at North Kessock, a scenic spot on the Beaulieu Firth where there is another chance to spot dolphins across from Chanonyr.

Tour Highlights | Dunvegan Castle, Quiraing, Kilt Rock, the Fairy Pools, Portree, Eilean Donan Castle



This 2-day small group tour with an overnight stay in Portree shows off the island's most spectacular sights whilst passing through beautiful highland scenery.

**DAY ONE:** Departing Inverness, we journey towards the Isle of Skye, pausing for a quick break at Achnasheen before reaching Loch Carron for photos. Afterward, we continue to Kyle of Lochalsh for another brief stop.

Crossing onto Skye, we head to **Dunvegan Castle**<sup>€</sup>. Situated on Loch Dunvegan's shore, this historic castle has been in the same family for over 800 years. Explore its fascinating history or enjoy lunch in Dunvegan village.

Next, we visit the breathtaking Quiraing mountain range. Its dramatic cliffs and rock formations make it a must-see for photographers. We then take in Skye's iconic landmarks: Kilt Rock,

Lealt Falls, and the Old Man of Storr, perfect additions to your Skye bucket list.

Our day concludes in Portree, where we check into your accommodation for the night.

**DAY TWO:** After breakfast, we visit the enchanting Fairy Pools, a magical spot steeped in legend. Walking boots are recommended for the journey to these beautiful waterfalls.
